## COTEAUX BOURGUIGNONS ROUGE

2023



*Ages of the vines* - 30 years

*Exposure* - north-east

*Soils* - Clay-limestone

### *Tasting notes*

A smooth, generous nose of blackberry, Cayenne pepper, flinty gunpowder and violet sweets. A liquorice backbone and rich aromas recalling cigar box and chalk. The palate is rounded and delicate, with a powdery texture. Long and flavorfull finish.

Pairing : Lamb shoulder croquette and kimchi

### *Wine Making*

The grapes are harvested manually, sorted, and vinified with 60% whole clusters. During the 11 days of fermentation, between 5 and 7 punch-downs are carried out, as well as pumping over. After pressing, the wines are settled for 2 weeks and put into barrels. Aging takes place entirely in barrels that are 1 to 5 years old. After 12 months of aging, the wines are racked into vats, rested for 3 months, and bottled without filtration or fining.

This wine is made from 30% Gamay and 70% Pinot Noir grapes grown in vineyards in Morey Saint Denis and the Hautes Côtes de Nuits.
